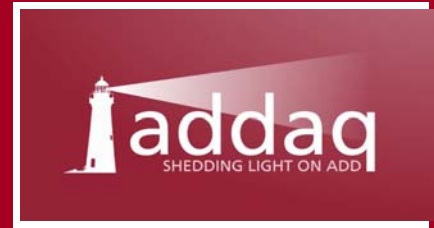

9.00am—10.15am Dr Andrew Martin: The Role of Motivation in Classroom Practice

Teachers, parents and other professionals are often concerned about the poor motivation shown by students to their classroom tasks. Many disciplinary problems in the classroom arise from low levels of motivation. It is amazing to see what children can accomplish when they are highly motivated. Dr Martin will discuss issues relating to motivation and will examine strategies which will improve student motivation.

10.15am—10.45am Morning Tea

10.45am—12.00pm Dr John Munro: Adapting teaching strategies to the needs of the learner with ADHD.

This session will consider the necessary adjustments to the classroom environment, teaching content, and learning processes to enable children with ADHD to function optimally. Dr Munro will suggest strategies which take account of the learning disabilities and learning styles of children with ADHD and other learning disabilities.

1.00pm—1.30pm Dr Leslie Ah Yui: The Uses and Limitations of medication with children who have ADHD

1.30pm—2.30pm Dr Andrew Martin: Strategies to develop Student Motivation

Motivation cannot be left to chance. Dr Martin will discuss ideas and strategies which can be very effective in increasing student motivation. The regular implementation of strategies to improve student motivation will have positive effects in the classroom.

2.30pm—3.00 Afternoon Tea

3.00pm—4.00pm Dr John Munro: Alternative teaching approaches for ADHD

This presentation will focus on teaching and supporting students in using cognitive learning strategies which serve to facilitate learning and reduce the load on working memory. These strategies will benefit all students in the classroom including those with ADHD.

4.00—4.40 Vivienne Williams

This presentation will examine Sensory Dysfunction and its impact on classroom learning and behavior with special reference to students with ADHD.

## CONFERENCE SPEAKERS

### Dr John Munro:

Associate Professor John Munro is Head of the Centre for Exceptional Learning in the Department of Learning and Educational Development in the University of Melbourne. His interests include: literacy learning and learning difficulties, developmental trends in phonemic awareness and its influence on learning to read and spell; maths and numeracy learning difficulties; gifted learning and literacy disabilities and creativity.

He has written articles and conducted research in these areas. His work has focused on helping students learn more effective thinking and learning strategies. Dr Munro often works with teachers in schools. He is interested in mapping the learning characteristics of children with learning difficulties. He has developed strategies for effective teaching and management. He has received awards from the Australian Association of Special Education and the Australian Remedial Education Association.

### Dr Andrew Martin:

Dr Martin is a psychologist and researcher specialising in educational psychology. He has conducted extensive research into student motivation, engagement and achievement. He is regarded as one of Australia's leading experts on motivation and its role in education. Dr Martin is regularly invited to present keynote conference papers, teacher professional development, and presentations to education departments. He has written a number of books as well as research papers for academic journals.

### Dr Leslie Ah Yui

Dr Ah Yui is a pediatrician with many years of experience in working with children with ADHD and in supporting and advising their parents.

### Vivienne Williams

Vivienne Williams is an occupational therapist at Corinda with a special interest in sensory integration dysfunction. She has extensive experience with children with ADHD
